Information:

Whilst primarily a **walking tour** covering some rough, uneven and undulating ground involving walks of up **to 3 miles across country** in a **hot climate**, we can always offer a less strenuous alternative. Our vehicle is always nearby and there are plenty of other opportunities available to savour all that this amazing battlefield and area has to offer. With our excellent guide to visitor ratio, we can ensure that you will always get personal attention whether out walking or enjoying another option.

Please ask if you have doubts about your health or physical fitness. A few practice walks before embarking on the tour might be beneficial and will add to your enjoyment. You must ensure that you have adequate travel and medical insurance cover for the duration of the tour. Please let us have the policy number and insurance company details before we depart.

Tour Cost and Payment:

We will once again be taking advantage of the fabulous facilities of the **Kum Hotel** which is situated just outside Eceabat.

Their website www.hotelkum.com details their rooms, bar, restaurant etc.

It provides an excellent base and in these uncertain times gives us a greater level of control over the environment and facilities.

Cost: Single room per person will be at **£1,500 for the 7-day tour which includes meals as detailed below.**

A **deposit of £400** is required at the time of booking **to secure a place** and a place on the tour will not be confirmed until payment has been received.

This deposit is not returnable in the event of the guest cancelling.

Air Fares are **NOT** included.

Please note that if there are not enough customers or the hotel prices are increased again, we reserve the right to seek alternative accommodation.

Of course, you will be advised of this change in good time.

Tour Start:

The Tour starts in Istanbul. This trip will start from the new International Istanbul Airport, we will confirm flight details and give a rendezvous time in due course.

DO NOT BOOK ANY FLIGHTS BEFORE THE TOUR IS CONFIRMED

The advantage of using the new International Istanbul Airport is that there are many flights to and from different UK destinations. So you should be able to find a flight from a convenient location for you that will get you to and from International Istanbul Airport. If you wish to spend a few days in Turkey, whether in Istanbul or at one of the other great attractions within this country, our tour operators will be able to arrange something for you. Let us know what you wish to do and we will put you in touch with them.

Evening meals will usually be at 8.00 or 8.30pm depending on our return time from the battlefield.
